*From the Principal's Desk*

A Valentines's Dance (the Grade 7 fundraiser) will be held in our school hall this Friday 15 February from 6:00 – 9:00pm. All **Grade 4-7** learners are invited to attend. Tickets will cost R50 per person which is to be paid to the register class teacher by this Wednesday. The colour theme for the evening is pink/red/white/black. Chips, cooldrinks & chocolate will be on sale for the evening. Valentine's Day goodies will also be on sale. ***Please ensure that your child is fetched at 9pm sharp.***

All learners will be allowed to wear civvies – red, white or black this Friday, 15 February 2019. The charge for this will be R5 each. Please pay the money to your child's class teacher by this Wednesday. Children must be dressed conservatively and not inappropriately!

Please ensure that your child is dressed in the correct school uniform on a normal school day, with the correct school socks, hairstyles, earrings and hairbands for girls, boys' white shirts must have the school badge on the pocket, the length of girls dresses should not be higher than 2 fingers width above the knee, etc. We find that some children come to school dressed sloppily and parents may not be aware of this if you leaving home for work before your children.

The HPV vaccination for Grade 4 – 6 girls will be administered by the Department of Health on 22 February 2019. These girls were issued with a 2 page letter from the Department of Health. Please read it carefully and sign and return the forms by this Friday 15 February 2019 to your child's class teacher. Children without parental consent will not receive these vaccinations. Please note further that girls who have already received their 2 injections will not be required to receive it again.

If your child is seriously ill, please keep him/her at home where recovery can take place or if a doctor needs to be consulted. Please refrain from sending a very sick child to school.

- **Photo's** - Please note that school photographs will be taken on 6 March 2019. The cost of the package of photos is R40. - **Left behind** - We are appealing to parents not to deliver items that your child has left behind or the parent has gone early morning shopping to bring to the learner – food; money; projects; sports kit; clothes; house keys; etc. What is left behind stays behind! Parents, children will never learn responsibility if you keep running after them. Please instill in them the habit of packing their bags and getting ready for school the night before! This also disrupts classes and lessons when children are constantly called up to the office.
- **Lost and found** - Parents, please insert a clear label with your child's name, surname & grade on all your child's uniform items (this applies to all learners in Grade R–7). We have a large number of uniform items in the Lost & Found container *without* labels, and we find that learners (and sometimes even parents) claim uniform items that do not even belong to them. Please note that all lost uniform items without labels will be washed and sent to our uniform shop for resale.
