Welcome back to the second term. I trust that you all had a refreshing and a restful break. We now have to push forward towards another busy term. Parents, please encourage your children to work hard from day one – your child can achieve good results if he/she is disciplined in body, mind and soul. If we work together, we can unlock the true potential in our children. Instilling good habits in them from an early age will stand them in good stead later in life. You will be advised when Term 1 reports will be issued.

Please note that learners must still come to school in summer uniform. However, please get your children’s winter uniforms in readiness. You will be advised when change over will take place. Boys and girls wear the same winter uniform. Formal uniform is as follows: black shoes; school socks; long grey pants; white collar long sleeved shirt; school tie; school jersey; school blazer; PT uniform: Long PT tracksuit with black takkies. Correct hair styles and earrings for girls to be adhered to as well (NO highlights, streaks, wedges, etc.). Children with incorrect hair styles will be sent home. Also note that cellphones are NOT ALLOWED at school. If cellphones or any other electronic devices are brought to school, they will be confiscated, and a fine of R200 will be levied for its return.

Parents, please note that every child MUST wear a mask to school – especially indoors. Please ensure that your child has a mask (and even a spare one in their bags) before they leave home.

We have commenced with our scholar patrol teams from today. Please respect our learners who are volunteering their time and effort to help cross our learners safely. We appeal to all parents and motorists – please drive extremely carefully when approaching the school. Especially at the scholar patrol, we find a number of motorists stopping, turning or reversing directly in front of the scholar patrol – this is illegal and dangerous for children crossing the road. Please be considerate by dropping your child off away from the scholar patrol crossing. It would be appreciated if parents could drop off their children on the vacant land across the school on Dalbini Drive and not stop at the small pedestrian gate. Children can then use the scholar patrol to cross over. Vehicle registration numbers will be handed to JMPD of those motorists who do not comply.

- **No cell phones, tablets or any other electronic devices are allowed at school –** If you are caught with these items, it will be confiscated and a penalty fee of R200.00 will be charged to get it back.
- **Left behind** - We are appealing to parents not to deliver items that your child has left behind or the parent has gone early morning shopping to bring to the learner – food; money; projects; sports kit; clothes; house keys; etc. What is left behind stays behind! Parents, children will never learn responsibility if you keep running after them. Please instill in them the habit of packing their bags and getting ready for school the night before! This also disrupts classes and lessons when children are constantly called up to the office.
- **Lost and found** - Parents, please insert a clear label with your child's name, surname & grade on all your child's uniform items (this applies to all learners in Grade R–7). We have a large number of uniform items in the Lost & Found container *without* labels, and we find that learners (and sometimes even parents) claim uniform items that do not even belong to them. Please note that all lost uniform items without labels will be washed and sent to our uniform shop for resale.
- **Absent from School** – If your child is not at school for 1 or 2 days, kindly write a note in the diary to the educator and if necessary supply the sick note. If your child is off longer than 2 days – Kindly notify the school, write a note in the diary and you will need to supply a sick note.
