From the Principal's Desk

Please note that we will be changing over to summer uniform from today, 6 September all learners to be in full summer uniform. Girls – summer dress, white socks, black shoes, Boys – open neck white shirt with grey shorts (only the Grade 7 boys are allowed to wear long grey pants the whole year), MPS grey school socks. Correct hairstyles, correct hair bands and earrings for girls, correct socks and shoes must be adhered to. Please note that **no mixing** of uniforms are allowed eg. track suit jackets with formal grey pants or track pants with jerseys are not allowed. Please ensure that your child takes pride in their appearance.

Parents, please insert a clear label with your child's name, surname & grade on all your child's uniform items (this applies to all learners in Grade R–7). We have a large number of uniform items in the Lost & Found container **without** labels, and we find that learners (and sometimes even parents) claim uniform items that do not even belong to them. Please note that all lost uniform items without labels cannot be claimed for and these will be washed and sent to our uniform shop for resale.

The second round of the HPV vaccination for 9 year old girls will be administered by the Department of Health **this** Wednesday and Thursday, 8 & 9 August 2021 for those Grade 4/5 girls whose parents have **signed** consent forms for this vaccination. Please note as well that the Department of Health will be administering de-worming tablets to all Grade R–7 learners this Wednesday and Thursday, 8 & 9 August 2021, provided they have sufficient stock – please sign the attached health consent forms granting permission for your child to take these de-worming tablets and return these forms to your child's class teacher. Children without parental consent will not receive these vaccinations or de-worming tablets.

Please be reminded that the **Admissions Process for 2022** is in two phases. First Phase: Grade 8 applications started on the 10 August 2021 until 3 September (this is now closed). **Second Phase: Grade 1 applications will start on the 13 September 2021, on-line** – please log onto **gdeadmissions.gov.za**. Parents who wish to apply for the other internal grades, Grade R and Grades 2-7 can apply directly to the school as of the 10 August 2021. The application forms for these grades will be available on our website – www.mulbartonprimary.co.za. Parents can download the appropriate application form, complete and sign and bring it to the school with the originally certified documents not older than 3 months. If your child, in Grades 1–6, will be attending this school next year, please ensure that the **Re-enrolment** form is sent back immediately. Failing to do so will result in your child not being placed into a class for 2022.
