Congratulations to all those learners who will be recipients of Honours Awards. Your hard work paid off. You have certainly done the school and your parents proud!

We are appealing to parents to please donate any second hand uniform that is still in a good condition to the school if your child has outgrown them or if they are leaving the school. This will certainly help those children who are in need.

Grade 1-6 parents – please note that if you intend on transferring your child to another school in January 2021, **please inform the school via a letter this week** to ensure that a Transfer Card is issued, also confirm that your school fees are paid up to date.

Parents please ensure that all learners are well prepared for their first school day in 2021 – correct stationery and books, school uniform, school shoes and correct hair styles (NO highlights, streaks, wedges, etc.). School re-opens on 27/28 January 2021. We will be continuing with the 50% daily rotation plan.
