Parents, please note that extra murals takes place on Tuesdays and Wednesdays only from 14h00 until 14h45. Please note that **ONLY** learners who have returned the signed consent form will be allowed to participate in extra mural activities. Learners are **NOT** allowed to leave their extra murals early and walk around the school or loiter outside. Learners not participating in extra murals **MUST** be fetched on time. Please let your child know at which gate they will be fetched after extra murals – Grade 1-3 on Archibald Avenue and Grade 4-7 on Dalbini Drive). Some extra murals are overcrowded and may be split into 2 groups, either on a Tuesday or a Wednesday – we will inform you of any changes.

The HPV vaccination for Grade 5 girls will be administered by the Department of Health on 2 March 2022. These girls were issued with a consent form from the Department of Health. Please read it carefully and sign and return the forms by this Friday 18 February 2022 to your child’s class teacher. Children without parental consent will not receive these vaccinations. Please note further that girls who have already received their 2 injections will not be required to receive it again.

Please note that school photographs will be taken on 23 February 2022. The cost of the package of photos is R40. Please send the money to your child’s educator as soon as possible. *The cut-off date for payment of photo money is on Monday, 21 February 2022.* On the day – please ensure that your child is in full formal summer uniform and to be neat and tidy. No tracksuits or PT uniform for the photo’s please.

Parents, please check your child’s bag on a daily basis. There are some children that are bringing undesired items to school and you may not be aware of it.

- **No cell phones, tablets or any other electronic devices are allowed at school**  
– If you are caught with these items, it will be confiscated and a penalty fee of R200.00 will be charged to get it back.
- **Left behind** - We are appealing to parents not to deliver items that your child has left behind or the parent has gone early morning shopping to bring to the learner – food; money; projects; sports kit; clothes; house keys; etc. What is left behind stays behind! Parents, children will never learn responsibility if you keep running after them. Please instill in them the habit of packing their bags and getting ready for school the night before! This also disrupts classes and lessons when children are constantly called up to the office.
- **Lost and found** - Parents, please insert a clear label with your child's name, surname & grade on all your child's uniform items (this applies to all learners in Grade R–7). We have a large number of uniform items in the Lost & Found container *without* labels, and we find that learners (and sometimes even parents) claim uniform items that do not even belong to them. Please note that all lost uniform items without labels will be washed and sent to our uniform shop for resale.
- **Absent from School** – If your child is not at school for 1 or 2 days, kindly write a note in the diary to the educator and if necessary supply the sick note. If your child is off longer than 2 days – Kindly notify the school, write a note in the diary and you will need to supply a sick note.
