Please ensure that all text books are returned to the subject teacher on the day your child writes that particular subject paper. Textbooks that are lost or damaged must be paid for – a cost of R150 is payable for lost/damaged books on the day when the books are collected. Please note that we cannot issue a textbook to the next grade learner if it is not in a good condition – take note that teachers have recorded the condition of the books on the day it was issued and will not accept those books in a condition worse than it was when issued at the beginning of the year. Please take note of the following with regards to damaged textbooks:

- Cover or pages ripped/torn out.
- Book covers missing.
- Cover or pages have been scarred with any stains or spills.
- Cover or pages have dog-ears.
- Cover or pages have handwritings or scribblings on it.

There will be a civvies day fundraiser this Friday, 25 October. Learners will be allowed to wear their civvies attire on Friday at a cost of R10 per learner. Monies to be paid to the class teacher by this Thursday. Please be reminded that learners need to dress conservatively.

We will have 2 more weeks of extra murals before the final examinations commence. Extra murals will end on 31 October 2024. Children who are not part of any extra mural should be gone home and not loiter around the school.

## Reminders

- **School Shop (for uniform) is open Tuesday and Friday from 07h30 – 08h00**

- **No cell phones, tablets or any other electronic devices are allowed at school** – If you are caught with these items, it will be confiscated and a penalty fee of R200.00 will be charged to get it back.
- **Left behind** - We are appealing to parents not to deliver items that your child has left behind or the parent has gone early morning shopping to bring to the learner – food; money; projects; sports kit; clothes; house keys; etc. What is left behind stays behind! Parents, children will never learn responsibility if you keep running after them. Please instill in them the habit of packing their bags and getting ready for school the night before! This also disrupts classes and lessons when children are constantly called up to the office.
- **Lost and found** - Parents, please insert a clear label with your child’s name, surname & grade on all your child’s uniform items (this applies to all learners in Grade R–7). We have a large number of uniform items in the Lost & Found container *without* labels, and we find that learners (and sometimes even parents) claim uniform items that do not even belong to them. Please note that all lost uniform items without labels will be washed and sent to our uniform shop for resale.
- **Absent from School** – If your child is not at school for 1 or 2 days, kindly write a note in the diary to the educator and if necessary supply the sick note. If your child is off longer than 2 days – Kindly notify the school, write a note in the diary and you will need to supply a sick note.
