From the Principal's Desk

All learners will be allowed to wear civvies – red, white or black – for Valentine's Day this Friday, 14 February 2025. This will be at a cost of R10 which must be paid to the register class teacher. Learners are to dress conservatively and appropriately. No fancy hairstyles or make-up will be allowed.

Cycle tests will start on Wednesday, 19 February (see attached Timetable – this was sent home with your child last week). Cycle tests will be written on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. Please ensure that your children are preparing thoroughly for these tests. Tests will be written in the morning and thereafter the normal class time table will be followed.

Please note that NOT all our parents are using the D6 school communicator, a convenient app on their mobile smart phones & desktops. There are approximately 1500 parents, so usage is low. Please download the School Communicator onto your PC, laptop or mobile phone for school info and news – www.school-communicator.com. If you have an android device, you can download using the Google Play store, or if you have an apple device, you can download using the iStore. Steps to download the school communicator are indicated on the school website [**Please select the Mulbarton Primary School with the SMALL logo**]. We are finding that we are printing 1200 hard copies of the newsletter and this is not even reaching majority of the parents. This is a wastage of ink and paper.

The HPV vaccination for Grade 5 girls will be administered by the Department of Health on Thursday, 13 March 2024. These girls were issued with a NEW consent form from the Department of Health last Friday. Children without parental consent will not receive these vaccinations. Please note further that girls who have already received their 2 injections will not be required to receive it again.

All learners from Grade R – 7 have been issued with school diaries. Please ensure that your child carries this to school every day as this is the first means of communication between parent and teacher. All parents (NOT learners) are required to complete the information

on inside front cover of the school diaries – this is important in helping to contact parents when the admin system cannot be accessed.
