Please note that the Honourable MEC for Education, Sports, Arts, Culture and Recreation, Mr. Maile, is inviting all stakeholders and the community to a public meeting to be held at Diversity High School on 22 June 2026 at 13h00 (see full notice on the school communicator and school website).

Parents Evening will take place next Thursday, 25 June 2026, between 17h00 and 19h00. Grade R – 3 parents may proceed directly to their child's class to collect the reports. Parents of grade 4 – 7 learners to first collect reports from the hall and then proceed to the respective educators' classrooms. ***Please note that all school fee accounts that are in arrears must be paid by 25 June 2026.***

Parents, please prepare for Learner Admissions for 2027 for new Grade 1 & Grade 8 learners which will only be done online. Admissions for new Grade R's and new Grades 2–7 will continue to take place manually. To all our current Grade R parents – please note that your Grade R child is ***not*** automatically enrolled into our Grade 1 class in 2027. Applications have to be completed online as well. Please note that you must apply to a school closest to where you and your child resides. All current Grade 7 learners must also apply online to the high school closest to where you reside. ***Please get all documents in readiness. As soon as the GDE opens the Admission period, parents will be informed when to start the application process.***

Reminders

- **School Shop (for uniform) is open Friday from 07h40 – 08h10**
- Please download the School Communicator onto your PC, laptop or mobile phone for school info and news www.school-communicator.com

- **No cell phones, tablets or any other electronic devices are allowed at school** – If you are caught with these items, it will be confiscated and a penalty fee of R250.00 will be charged to get it back.
- **Left behind** - We are appealing to parents not to deliver items that your child has left behind, or the parent has gone early morning shopping to bring to the learner – food; money; projects; sports kit; clothes; house keys; etc. What is left behind stays behind! Parents, children will never learn responsibility if you keep running after them. Please instill in them the habit of packing their bags and getting ready for school the night before! This also disrupts classes and lessons when children are constantly called up to the office. Learners will receive a demerit if any of the above items are received at reception.
- **Lost and found** - Parents, please insert a clear label with your child's name, surname & grade on all your child's uniform items (this applies to all learners in Grade R–7). We have a large number of uniform items in the Lost & Found container *without* labels, and we find that learners (and sometimes even parents) claim uniform items that do not even belong to them. Please note that all lost uniform items without labels will be washed and sent to our uniform shop for resale.
- **Absent from School** – If your child is not at school for 1 or 2 days, kindly write a note in the diary to the educator and if necessary, supply the sick note. If your child is off longer than 2 days – Kindly notify the school, write a note in the diary and you will need to supply a sick note.

Grade R – 2 = Monday to Friday 13h30
Grade 3 = Monday to Thursday = 14h00 and Friday = 13h30
Grade 4 – 7 = Monday and Thursday = 14h30 Tuesday and Wednesday = 14h00 and Friday 13h30
(Tuesday and Wednesday is Extral Murals which finishes at 14h45)
