Please note that all learners (Grades R-7) will be dismissed at 13h30 next Monday, 3 August, as many educators are attending district subject meetings. Please make the necessary transport arrangements.

Parents, please note that many children are coming to school without some of the basic stationery items such as writing books, pens, pencils, rulers, pritt, etc. This makes it very difficult for learners to complete their work in class. Please ensure that your child has all the necessary stationery items so that they do not fall behind in their classwork.

Please note that extra murals will commence on Wednesday, 29 July. Please encourage your child to participate in at least one extra mural this term. However, remember that academics take priority and if your child is struggling academically, s/he needs to attend remedial lessons in English, Mathematics or Afrikaans.

Please note that the **Application Period** for Learner Admissions for 2027 will open at 8am this Wednesday, 5 August 2026 to midnight on Friday, 4 September 2026. Admission for new Grade 1 & Grade 8 learners for 2027 will only be done online at www.gdeadmissions.gov.za during that period. In addition to the online application, forms from the school must also be completed with all the required certified documents.

Admissions for new Grade R's and new Grades 2–7 will continue to take place manually – forms for these grades must be collected from the school reception.

To all our current Grade R parents – please note that your Grade R child is *not* automatically enrolled into our Grade 1 class in 2027. Applications have to be completed online as well at the above mentioned web address. Please note that you must apply to a school closest to where you and your child resides. All current Grade 7 learners must also apply online to the high school closest to where you reside.

Reminders

- **School Shop (for uniform) is open Friday from 07h40 – 08h10**

- **No cell phones, tablets or any other electronic devices are allowed at school**
– If you are caught with these items, it will be confiscated and a penalty fee of R250.00 will be charged to get it back.
- **Left behind** - We are appealing to parents not to deliver items that your child has left behind, or the parent has gone early morning shopping to bring to the learner – food; money; projects; sports kit; clothes; house keys; etc. What is left behind stays behind! Parents, children will never learn responsibility if you keep running after them. Please instill in them the habit of packing their bags and getting ready for school the night before! This also disrupts classes and lessons when children are constantly called up to the office. Learners will receive a demerit if any of the above items are received at reception.
- **Lost and found** - Parents, please insert a clear label with your child's name, surname & grade on all your child's uniform items (this applies to all learners in Grade R–7). We have a large number of uniform items in the Lost & Found container *without* labels, and we find that learners (and sometimes even parents) claim uniform items that do not even belong to them. Please note that all lost uniform items without labels will be washed and sent to our uniform shop for resale.
- **Absent from School** – If your child is not at school for 1 or 2 days, kindly write a note in the diary to the educator and if necessary, supply the sick note. If your child is off longer than 2 days – Kindly notify the school, write a note in the diary and you will need to supply a sick note.
