From the Principal's Desk

SUMMER UNIFORM – Please note that we will be changing over to summer uniform from today. All learners to be in full summer uniform. Girls – summer dress, white socks, black shoes, Boys – open neck white shirt with grey shorts (only the Grade 7 boys are allowed to wear long grey pants the whole year), MPS grey school socks. Correct hairstyles, correct hair bands and earrings for girls, correct socks and shoes must be adhered to. Please note that **no mixing** of uniforms are allowed eg. track suit jackets with formal grey pants or track pants with jerseys are NOT allowed. Please ensure that your child takes pride in his/her appearance.

GRADE 7 MARKET DAY – Our **Grade 7 Market Day** will take place this Friday, 4 September 2026. This is the culmination of their business/entrepreneurship project for EMS. The Grade 7's will be selling various types of goods and food on the day. Majority of the school will be given an opportunity to purchase and support the grade 7's in their mini businesses! So please encourage your children to save their pocket money for this day. Children to bring along a plastic bag to hold all the items they purchase.

CYCLE TESTS – Parents, please note that Cycle Tests for Grade 4-7 will end next Monday, 7 September 2026. This applies to certain subjects only as the other subjects are project based for this term. Please refer to the Cycle Test timetable sent with learners.

SPRING DAY CIVVIES – There will be a Spring Day civvies next Friday, 11 September. Learners will be allowed to wear their spring attire on Friday at a cost of R10 per learner (This is for Grade R-7 learners). Learners to please hand in their monies to their class teacher. Please be reminded that learners need to dress conservatively.

ADMISSIONS GRADE 1 – 2027 – Please note that the **Application Period** for Learner Admissions for 2027 opened on 5 August 2026 up until midnight on 4 September 2026. Admission for new Grade 1 & Grade 8 learners for 2027 will only be done online at www.gdeadmissions.gov.za during that period.

Admissions for new Grade R's and new Grades 2–7 will continue to take place manually – forms for these grades must be collected from the school reception.

To all our current Grade R parents – please note that your Grade R child is **not** automatically enrolled into our Grade 1 class in 2027. Applications have to be completed online on the above mentioned web address. Please note that you must apply to a school closest to where you and your child resides. All current Grade 7 learners must also apply online to the high school closest to where you reside.

RE-REGISTRATION FORMS – Please note that **re-registration forms** (light blue in colour) were issued today to all learners in Grade 1-6. These forms **MUST** be returned to school to ensure that your child's academic place for 2027 is secured. This only applies to Grades 1-6 of 2026. Please complete and return to your child's class teacher by latest 22 September 2026.

- **No cell phones, tablets or any other electronic devices are allowed at school** – If you are caught with these items, it will be confiscated and a penalty fee of R250.00 will be charged to get it back.
- **Left behind** - We are appealing to parents not to deliver items that your child has left behind, or the parent has gone early morning shopping to bring to the learner – food; money; projects; sports kit; clothes; house keys; etc. What is left behind stays behind! Parents, children will never learn responsibility if you keep running after them. Please instill in them the habit of packing their bags and getting ready for school the night before! This also disrupts classes and lessons when children are constantly called up to the office. Learners will receive a demerit if any of the above items are received at reception.
- **Lost and found** - Parents, please insert a clear label with your child's name, surname & grade on all your child's uniform items (this applies to all learners in Grade R–7). We have a large number of uniform items in the Lost & Found container *without* labels, and we find that learners (and sometimes even parents) claim uniform items that do not even belong to them. Please note that all lost uniform items without labels will be washed and sent to our uniform shop for resale.
- **Absent from School** – If your child is not at school for 1 or 2 days, kindly write a note in the diary to the educator and if necessary, supply the sick note. If your child is off longer than 2 days – Kindly notify the school, write a note in the diary and you will need to supply a sick note.
